MARCIA CLARE HOFMANN, CLASS OF 2000, the Alumnae Association is pleased to honor you with the Achievement Award. This award is presented to alumnae whose accomplishments and service to society exemplify the values and virtues set forth by the College.

Marcia, as an internationally recognized expert on cybersecurity law, your pioneering work has focused on a broad range of civil liberties issues, including computer security, electronic privacy, free expression and copyright.

Your career began at the Electronic Privacy Information Center, where you served as staff counsel and director of open government projects. In this role you helped research and conduct policy analysis on consumer privacy and electronic surveillance issues. You also coauthored a dozen amicus curiae briefs on privacy and open government issues in cases before the U.S. Supreme Court, state supreme courts and federal appeals courts. As senior staff attorney at the Electronic Frontier Foundation, you litigated cases dealing with a wide range of technology issues, including privacy and digital civil liberties.

In 2013 you founded and became principal of Zeitgeist Law PC, San Francisco, a boutique law practice focusing on computer crime and information security. For three years you served as a fellow at Stanford Law School's Center for Internet and Society and as an adjunct professor at the University of California Hastings College of Law. As a board member for Without My Consent, you help to provide resources to empower individuals to stand up for their rights to privacy and free speech. Forbes magazine has noted that your innovative work in cybersecurity will be instrumental to our understanding of how the internet is present in all aspects of our society.

MARCIA, for your outstanding accomplishments, the Alumnae Association is honored to present you with the Achievement Award on this, your twentieth, reunion.
